## **TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF QUALITY ROW - MONDAY 24 OCTOBER 2022**

I, Andrew Roach, General Manager of the Norfolk Island Regional Council, under section 50 of the Traffic Act 2010, close part of the road specified in Part 1 of the Schedule to all vehicular traffic (except any vehicle specified in Part 2 of the Schedule) for the period and times indicated in Part 1 of the Schedule below **on Monday 24 October 2022** to enable a public function to be held on, or in the vicinity of the roads.

# **TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF FERNY LANE**
