PASTURAGE AND ENCLOSURE ACT 1949 APPLICATION FOR PASTURAGE RIGHTS FOR THE TWELVE MONTHS COMMENCING 1 APRIL 2023 PASTURAGE RIGHTS APPLICATIONS

In accordance with sub-section 5(a) and (b) of the *Pasturage and Enclosure Act 1949* (NI) a cattle owner may on the form provided, and during the last 14 days of December in any year apply to the General Manager for a right of pasturage for the year commencing on the next succeeding 1 April.

Application forms may be obtained from the Norfolk Island Regional Council's website <u>http://www.norfolkisland.gov.nf/council/council-documents/cattle</u> or from Customer Care,

To be eligible to be granted pasturage rights, an applicant must be an individual who:

- is at least 18 years of age, and
- must be an owner of stock

There are a limited number of pasturage rights available, and there will be no increase in the current number of tags in 2023 – 2024. The Norfolk Island Regional Council allocates pasturage rights according to its policies and procedures which are applicable at the time.

<u>Fees</u>

The fee payable for each head of cattle over the age of 6 months is \$150.00 and is payable after an applicant is advised if they have been successful in securing pasturage right(s).
