TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF SECTIONS OF FERNY LANE FOR PUBLIC SAFETY WORKS

I, **Andrew Roach**, General Manager of the Norfolk Island Regional Council, under section 50 of the *Traffic Act 2010* (NI), close that part, or parts, of the road specified in Part 1 of the Schedule to all vehicular traffic (except any vehicle specified in Part 2 of the Schedule) for the period 1 February 2023 to 31 December 2023:

SCHEDULE

Part 1 – 300 Meter Sections of Ferny Lane will be closed off to Traffic between 7am and 3pm weekdays starting from 1 February 2023 to 31 December 2023. This will enable the Roads crew to carry out the Re-Sealing works that is required on this section of the road. The timing and duration of each Road Closure will be broadcast on our local radio as required and road closures to be officially signposted by Council staff, or as directed by Council staff during the relevant periods.

Part 2 - Exempted classes of vehicles:

- a) Vehicles and plant authorised by the General Manager of the Norfolk Island Regional Council or delegate for the delivery of goods or services
- b) Council vehicles and plant involved on official business
- c) Police, ambulance, fire services and emergency vehicles on official business
- d) Vehicles authorised by OIC Police or delegate thereof
- e) Vehicles required by Burnt Pine Fuel for the discharge of fuel
