PASTURAGE AND ENCLOSURE ACT 1949

RIGHTS OF PASTURAGE FOR 2023 - 2024

I, **Philip Reid**, as Acting Chief Executive Officer and Acting General Manager of the Norfolk Island Regional Council under section 6 of the *Pasturage and Enclosure Act 1949* (NI) (*the Act*) grant to each of the applicants below, and subject to and conditional upon the payment by 4pm Friday 24 March 2022 (Norfolk Island time) of \$150 for each head of cattle to the Cashier, NIRC Customer Care Centre, Bicentennial Centre, Burnt Pine. **Proof of membership of the Norfolk Island Cattle Association Inc. is to be provided with payment.**

The rights of pasturage are granted for the year commencing on 1 April 2023 and ending 31 March 2024 to applicants for the number of head of cattle only indicated as follows:

1. A right of pasturage is also granted for the progeny of cattle referred to above, until that progeny(calf) attains the age of six months: provided the birth of that calf is notified to the Registrar of Brands and Marks within 7 days and it is tagged within one month of its birth.

2. Notice is given to each person named above, that they are prohibited from depasturing a head of cattle in respect of which a right has been granted, if that animal does not have an identifying tag attached to it as issued in accordance with section 7 of the *Pasturage and Enclosure Act 1949*

3. Tag owners must remove cattle without tags, injured, sick or in poor condition within 48 hours or forfeit all allocated tags.
