BIRDS PROTECTION ACT 1913 (NI) OPEN SEASON: WHALE BIRD EGGS

I, **George Plant**, Administrator of Norfolk Island and delegate of the Commonwealth Minister, under item 1.09 of the *Ministers Norfolk Island Delegation Instrument 2019 (CTH)*, declare the period —

28 September 2023 to 04 November 2023 (both dates inclusive)

to be an open season in relation to the —

whale bird (Sooty Tern Onychoprion fuscatus)

limited to the taking of eggs of the whale bird for non-commercial human consumption with the exception of the National Park zones on Norfolk Island, the Cord (both inside and outside the National Park) and the adjacent northern islets.

NOTE:

The effect of the above notice is to allow the taking of whale bird eggs between 28 September 2021 to 4 November 2021. The taking of EGGS is permitted for non-commercial human consumption only, and the species must not otherwise be interfered with. Eggs may not be harvested from the National Park zones on Norfolk Island.
