DOG REGISTRATION ACT 1936 (NI)

The public is reminded that dog registrations will expire on 1 January 2024 and that the keeping of an unregistered dog is an offence.

It is the responsibility of the owner / keeper to ensure that any dog over the age of 6 months is registered and wearing a current registration tag issued by the Registrar of Dogs.

Owners of dogs are therefore encouraged to ensure that their dog is registered and that the identification tag is affixed to the dog within 14 days after it has been issued.

Application forms for registration of dogs are available online at Council's website under customer care forms or from the Customer Care office in the Bicentennial Complex, Taylors Road during normal business hours.
