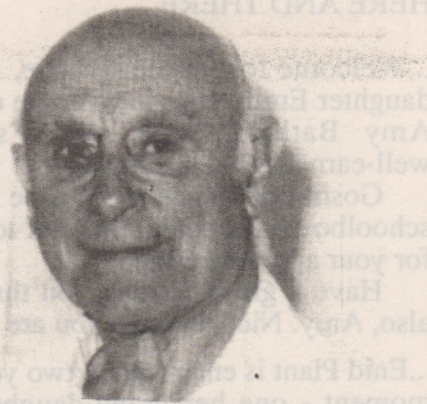
...Our photo shows Mr. and Mrs. Johnston - Joan and Eric- from Mississauga, Ontario who are parents of Tony Johnston.

Many will remember Bill Baldwin .

We received a letter this week from his son Bill Baldwin of Sadliers Crossing, Queensland advising of the death of his Dad - Bernard Wilfred - on October 24th.

The Baldwin family lived on Norfolk Island in the early 1920's and 30's and Bill, who had the first Ford Dealership on the island, actually imported the very first car here.

In those days they would show an announcement on the picture screen in the old Rawson Hall ,( situated then opposite the turn-off to Bumboras and called the "Talkies") advising the public that Bill would be driving his car around on such and such a day or days.

Bill's garage was, we understand, on the site of the present Central Garage.

Preceded by a private cremation a Service of Thanksgiving for Bill Baldwin's lifewas held at the Uniting Church in Ashbury which is near Ashfield, one of the Western suburbs of Sydney ,where Bill had apparently lived for many years , as the funeral notice said "formerly of Ashbury and Seaforth".

Bill was the father and father-in-law of Bill and Meg, Peter and Coralie, Ruth and Don and Doug and Judy, grandfather and great-grandfather to their children and was 91 years of age.
