REGULATIONS ABOUT ACTIVITIES DURING THE NORFOLK ISLAND REGIONAL COUNCIL ELECTION

The Local Government (General) Regulation 2005 (NSW) as applied on Norfolk Island, contains rules relating to the display and publishing of materials concerning the election, referring to any candidate or indicating how to vote for the Norfolk Island Regional Council Election to be held on Saturday 28 May 2016.

These regulations provide:

- *Electoral material must be registered with the Returning Officer at 36 E and F Taylors Road (closes on Friday 20 May at 5pm)*
- *Electoral material must state the name and address of by whom it was authorised and by whom it was printed*
- *offences for display or publishing material that does not comply with these requirements*
- *confiscation by election officials or by the Police of material that does not comply with the requirements*

Please note the regulated period for the election commenced on 18 April 2016 and continues until 6pm on election day, 28 May 2016.
